5–13 JANUARY

Hobart will be transformed this January as it plays host to some of the world's best tennis players.

- Look to appoint student to run own tennis tournament (run at club locations around state)

EVENT/FUNCTIONS ASSISTANT

Assist in organisation and running of our tennis awards night.
